Glen Boles was born in New Brunswick in 1934 and came to Calgary, Alberta, in 1953. A few years later he was persuaded to go climbing by fellow worker and mountain guide, Heinz Kahl. With Kahl and Brian Greenwood he was introduced to the more serious side of the sport. Since then, Glen has climbed extensively in Canada and also in Alaska and Europe, but his first love is the Canadian Rockies where he has summited over 450 peaks, often by a difficult new route. Many were first ascents. Over the years Glen became familiar with all facets of climbing, from expedition climbing to mountain rescue. But more than anything he has enjoyed climbing with the Grizzly Group, a small group of friends dedicated to making first ascents in the remoter regions of the Rockies. In the winter he is an avid skier, both backcountry and downhill. For 13 years he was a member of the Canadian Ski Patrol at Lake Louise Ski Resort.
