But as the quest for the whale becomes increasingly perilous, the tale works on allegorical levels, likening the whale to human greed, moral consequence, good, evil, and life itself. The novel was scorned by critics upon its publication in 1851, partially because whaling and maritime adventuring were no longer of topical interest to the American public - the Gold Rush had shifted focus to the West. But its reputation as a Great American Novel of unquestionably epic proportions grew during the 20th century. Moby-Dick is one of the greatest works of imaginations in literary history, doubtless the greatest book of the sea ever written.
