Brand New Book ***** Print on Demand *****.Excerpt from Efficiency Studies in Dairy Farming: May, 1933 For the year ending March 31, 1932, the family labor incomes of 38 farmers in Grafton county varied from a loss of \$964 to a gain of \$1721. Thirteen farmers had family labor incomes ranging from \$711 to \$1721, 13 others ranged from \$184 to \$670, and the 12 lowest ranged from a loss of \$964 to a gain of \$162. These differences are no greater than those usually found in similar studies in this and in other areas. Two years earlier the results of a farm management survey of 414 farms, reported in New Hampshire Agricultural Experiment Station Bulletin 260, showed a range in labor incomes from a loss of \$2,679 to a gain of \$5.138. Why such differences in net returns? A study of records in 1930 showed that some of the variations in returns are associated with differences in size of business as measured by farm acreage, crop acreage, number of cows, and productive man work units.
